Timeline for orders for 2009 Try-outs

- **Uniform Orders must be turned into me no later than June 23, 2009.**
- **Uniform orders will be placed to Soccer Master no later than June 26, 2009.**
- **Uniform orders will be sent to Adidas on June 29, 2009 with a ship date of July 11, 2009. Once uniforms arrive in KC, screening and numbering takes 2 weeks.**
- **Estimated arrival date for pickup of uniforms at Soccer Master is August 6, 2009.**

Pricing for Uniforms

- **Full Kit: 1 short, 2 jerseys, 1 pair of socks, sweatsuit with all logos and numbers: \$170 when ordered by June 23, 2009. Uniforms ordered after June 23, 2009, will be \$175.**
- **Partial Kit: 1 short, 2 jerseys, and 1 pair of socks with logos and numbers: \$90 if ordered by June 23, 2009. Uniforms ordered after June 23, 2009 are \$95.**
- **Individual Item Pricing (includes all logos and numbers)**
 1. **White Squadra jersey: \$25.00**
 2. **Blue Golpe jersey: \$45.00**
 3. **Shorts: \$25.00**
 4. **Socks: \$6.00**
 5. **Sweat pants: \$33.00**
 6. **Sweat jacket: \$48.00**
 7. **Bag with number: \$35**
- **Younger team orders (not the “official” kit) will order as follows(U9 and younger teams)**
 1. **Camp II shorts: Sizes available are 10, 12, 16. (Shorts are the same as the “official” kit)**
 2. **2 t-shirts with logo and number: Sizes available are YM and YL. Colors available are black, white, yellow, or grey.**
 3. **Cost: \$40.00**



Forms to use for ordering:

1. **Uniform orders placed at Try-outs need to be sent via email to futurauniforms@embarqmail.com. They need to be sent on the Form labeled Team Uniform Order.**
2. **Uniform orders placed after try-outs or throughout the season need to use the same form. They need to be sent via email to futurauniforms@embarqmail.com.**
3. **Younger teams not ordering the “official” uniform kit may use the FFC Quick Order Form to submit their uniform order to futurauniforms@embarqmail.com.**

Uniform Payment Procedures:

1. **Uniform payments need to be mailed to Kenda Childers, 9611 S. Gibson Rd., Lone Jack, MO 64070.**
2. **Uniform checks should be made out to Futura FC.**
3. **Uniform checks need to be received by Kenda before your order can be picked up at Soccer Master.**

Uniform Pick-up Procedures: (NEW PROCEDURES)

1. **Managers will be responsible for picking up uniforms from Soccer Master. This is a change from the past. I know this will be a bit more work on managers, but I think it will speed up the process of your getting the uniforms to your players. Managers can have parents pick up uniforms as long as the parents are aware of the procedures for pick up.**
2. **Procedure for pick-up: Once an order comes in to Soccer Master, I will get a call or email that it has arrived. If I have received your payment, I can then let you know that your order is ready and you can arrange to pick it up. The key here is that I can not let you pick up your order until I have your money in hand. Soccer Master will not set your order out for pick-up until I authorize that to be done based on your payment being received.**
3. **Pick-up at Soccer Master: Orders will be labeled with the manager’s name and set out for pick up once I tell Soccer Master the order has been paid for. Whoever picks up the order will go to Soccer Master and let them know they need to pick up a team order and the name of the manager. They will then sign for the order and take the order.**



Tips for Successful Ordering:

- 1. Have all players coming through try-outs try on the uniform pieces and complete a sizing sheet.**
- 2. Managers need to take the sizing sheets for your age group / team from try-outs so that you have them to make your team order.**
- 3. As soon as your coach is telling a player they have a spot, contact them and make sure you have their sizes together.**
- 4. If you think your team will be picking up players between now and season, then order at least a basic kit to have on hand. For the most part, picking the size for an extra player isn't too difficult.**
- 5. If you have players leaving, try to buy back their uniforms and sell them to a new person on your team.**

IMPORTANT INFO

- 1. Uniform orders can take 4-6 weeks from the time I place the order.**
- 2. Uniform orders must be made in groups of 12 for anything that has to be logo'd, so sometimes I have to let orders stack up before placing the order with Soccer Master. Even when I have blank jerseys on hand, they must be logoed in groups of 12 or there is extra cost attached. This is why it is important to try to have at least 1 extra uniform per team on hand. If we all have an extra uniform per team, we can even sell to each other when we add a player. I know this means some up front cost, but it will make adding a new player an easier process and the money will eventually come back to the team. If your roster is full, then obviously you don't need to worry about this.**
- 3. Uniform buy-backs can be arranged so that players leaving the club could sell their uniform to a player needing a uniform. To determine price, managers working with the players can assess the status of the uniform and assist with the purchase. Cost is to be agreed upon by both players. A general rule is that uniforms are to last 2 years, so 1 year is about half the life of the uniform. Other situations can be pro-rated as both parties agree.**
